PED's disclaimer about using SY 2020-2021 data

"PED advises users of state assessment results from 2020-2021 to first examine the <u>enrollment rates</u> of students in 2021 compared to 2019 and then ensure the <u>test participation rate</u> for all students and all <u>identifiable subgroups</u> of students is at least 80%. Even if these thresholds are met, classroom, building, and district level results must be <u>interpreted cautiously</u> and considered in context of students' opportunity to learn grade-level curriculum during the 2020-21 school year. If the participation rate and representation thresholds are not met, <u>aggregate information</u> should not be used. Individual student results may be used in context."
