Internet Connectivity Issues at Home

- 1. On the last question of every test session, the finish button will be activated to allow you to click **Finish**.
- 2. The **Test Review Page** displays a full list of questions with their answer status.
 - a. **Answered** questions will be displayed in blue
 - b. **Unanswered** questions will be displayed in red.
 - c. **Bookmarked** questions will display with a star.
 - d. Pause/Exit allows you to pause or exit the test.
 - e. Return to Test allows you to go back into the test
- 3. Click Turn In button to submit the test.
- 4. You are prompted one final time to confirm that you wish to turn in the test, at this prompt you will be notified if you have unanswered questions. Clicking **Turn In**, submits the test for scoring.

If internet connectivity goes in and out during testing you will be able to continue to take your test, your responses will be saved in your browser's cache.

If there is no internet connectivity when you turn in your test you will see a message providing instructions. The message will instruct you to relaunch the web browser on your testing device and navigate to the student test interface (https://newmexico.cognia.org/student/) after internet connectivity has been restored. This will force any test data saved on the browser to be sent for scoring.

Additional information on what to do in this situation, as well as information on other error messages you may see are outlined in the <u>Browser</u> <u>Testing User Guide</u>.

NOTE: Do not clear browsing data/cache when you are trying to establish internet connection during testing or submitting a test offline.
