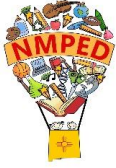
- **When will the results be available?**
 - The student data files are available in [Data Interaction](#) on August 26, 2022
 - The actual PDFs of the Individual Student Reports (ISRs) will be available in Data Interaction for download in the Download Center no later than October 3, 2022
 - The actual printed reports will be shipped and arrive in state no later than October 26, 2022

- **How do I access my results as a District Test Coordinator (DTC)?**
 - As a DTC, you will be able to access your results in Data Interaction by logging into the portal and clicking on the “reporting” icon
 - Please refer to the [Data Interaction user guide](#) for additional details.

- **Will I receive standards-level results?**
 - Yes, LEAs will receive an item-analysis level report for both the MSSA and ASR

- **Will I be able to download the results for my entire district at once?**
 - No, unfortunately, at this time, we do not have that option in Data Interaction
 - You will need to download them by grade for each school

- **Are we able to see the state level data in Data Interaction as well?**
 - Yes, you can view the state level summary data when running a summary report by selecting New Mexico State as one of the organizations on the summary report

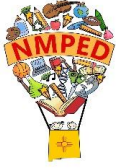


- **Does MSSA have the same number of performance levels as iMSSA?**
 - No. MSSA and iMSSA are two distinct assessments and they do not have the same performance levels
 - iMSSA has 3 performance levels:
 - On Target
 - Near Target
 - Needs Support
 - MSSA has 4 performance levels:
 - Novice
 - Nearing Proficiency
 - Proficient
 - Advanced

- **What are the cut scores for MSSA and ASR for each grade level?**
 - You can find them in the Help & Support Site under the MSSA and ASR [Reporting Resources](#) section

- **How long will the data reports be available in Data Interaction (DI)?**
 - They will be available year over year
 - If you administered MSSA in 2021, for instance, you would have access to the 2020-21 and 2021-22 reports
 - Next year, you would have access to the 2022-23 reports as well as the previous years

- **Will we have access to growth reports for MSSA and ASR?**
 - No, there are no growth reports available for MSSA or ASR
 - There are growth reports available only for iMSSA and indicates the growth from the previous iMSSA administration window, e.g., growth from BOY iMSSA to MOY iMSSA and from MOY iMSSA to EOY iMSSA



➤ **Will we have item analysis reports available as well like we do for iMSSA?**

- Yes, there will also be item analysis reports for MSSA and ASR
- They will be available on September 16, 2022

➤ **Is it possible to see the item/exact question from the Item Analysis Report? When checking the report, it only pulls the following information:**

- It is not possible because it would mean releasing the entire item completely and giving the answer away.
- The reason you see the item analysis report the way you do is so that we can share the item description, item metadata and as many details as possible without sharing the actual item and compromising the security of the item.
