Scale Score

The scale score shows the student's level of achievement in accordance with the knowledge and skills necessary at their grade level and in each reported content area, as aligned with the New Mexico Academic Standards.

Students receive a numerical scale score that falls within a set range and indicates one of four performance levels: Advanced, Proficient, Nearing Proficiency, or Novice. For **English Language Arts** and Mathematics a Lexile or Quantile score is given.
